According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Maryland, there were 3 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, October 1, 2023. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 10 percent short, 74 percent adequate, and 16 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 14 percent very short, 11 percent short, 64 percent adequate, and 11 percent surplus.

In Delaware, there were 2 days suitable for fieldwork. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 4 percent short, 50 percent adequate, and 46 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 15 percent short, 63 percent adequate, and 22 percent surplus.
