



**DELMARVA AGRICULTURE DATA
WEEKLY BROILER CHICKS REPORT**

PLACEMENTS UP 1%

For the week ending June 25, 2005, growers placed 11.8 million broiler chicks in Delmarva growing houses, according to the Maryland Agricultural Statistics Service. These placements were 1.4 above the comparable week a year earlier. Broiler-type chicks hatched (11.8 million) increased 1.7% from comparable week in 2004. Eggs set in incubators during the week totaled 14.3 million, an increase of 2.1% from the same week a year earlier. Federally inspected slaughter on Delmarva was 11.4 million for the week ending June 18, 2005 compared to 10.9 million slaughtered during the same week in 2004.
