



**DELMARVA AGRICULTURE DATA  
WEEKLY BROILER CHICKS REPORT**

**PLACEMENTS UP 5%**

For the week ending October 15, 2005, growers placed 11.7 million broiler chicks in Delmarva growing houses, according to the Maryland Agricultural Statistics Service. These placements were 5.2% above the comparable week a year earlier. Broiler-type chicks hatched (11.7 million) increased 5.2% from comparable week in 2004. Eggs set in incubators during the week totaled 13.8 million, an increase of 7.5% from the same week a year earlier. Federally inspected slaughter on Delmarva was 11.7 million for the week ending October 08, 2005 compared to 11.8 million slaughtered during the same week in 2004.
