PLACEMENTS DOWN 1%

For the week ending October 07, 2006, growers placed 10.8 million broiler chicks in Delmarva growing houses, according to the Maryland Field Office of USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. These placements were 1.5% below the comparable week a year earlier. Broiler-type chicks hatched (10.7 million) decreased 2.0% from comparable week in 2005. Eggs set in incubators during the week totaled 13.7 million, an increase of 0.8% from the same week a year earlier. Federally inspected slaughter on Delmarva was 11.3 million for the week ending September 30, 2006 compared to 11.5 million slaughtered during the same week in 2005.
