## **Sheep and Goat Inventory**

All sheep and lamb inventory in Michigan on January 1, 2024, was 82,000 head, unchanged from 2023, according to Marlo D. Johnson, Regional Director of the USDA, NASS, Great Lakes Regional Office. Breeding sheep inventory, at 59,000 head, was unchanged from last year. Market sheep and lambs totaled 23,000 head, unchanged from last year. The 2023 Michigan lamb crop was 53,000 head, up 2,000 from the previous year.

All sheep and lambs inventory in the United States on January 1, 2024 totaled 5.03 million head, down 2 percent from 2023. Breeding sheep inventory at 3.67 million head on January 1, 2024, decreased 2 percent from 3.74 million head on January 1, 2023. Ewes one year old and older, at 2.87 million head, were 2 percent below last year. Market sheep and lambs on January 1, 2024 totaled 1.36 million head, down 2 percent from January 1, 2023.

The number of sheep and lambs shorn in Michigan, at 58,000 head, was unchanged from the previous year. Michigan shorn wool production in 2023 was 340,000 pounds, unchanged from 2022. The average price paid for wool in Michigan was \$0.70 per pound, up \$0.10 from the previous year. The total value of wool was \$238,000, \$34,000 above the 2022 value.

Shorn wool production in the United States during 2023 was 22.7 million pounds, down 2 percent from 2022. Sheep and lambs shorn totaled 3.22 million head, down 2 percent from 2022. The average price paid for wool sold in 2023 was \$1.56 per pound for a total value of 35.3 million dollars, down 1 percent from 35.5 million dollars in 2022.

As of January 1, 2024, there were 11,000 milk goats in Michigan, unchanged from a year earlier.

All goats and kids inventory in the United States on January 1, 2024 totaled 2.47 million head, down 2 percent from 2023. Breeding goat inventory totaled 2.03 million head, down 2 percent from 2023. Does one year old and older, at 1.51 million head, were 2 percent below last year's number. Market goats and kids totaled 438,700 head, down 4 percent from a year ago.
