



SOYBEANS Bushels Produced in 2004






CORN Bushels Produced in 2004






ALL WHEAT Bushels Produced in 2004






ALL HAY Tons Produced in 2004






ALL CATTLE & CALVES

Number of Head, January 1, 2005






ALL HOGS

Number of Head, December 1, 2004






MILK COWS

Number of Head, January 1, 2005




