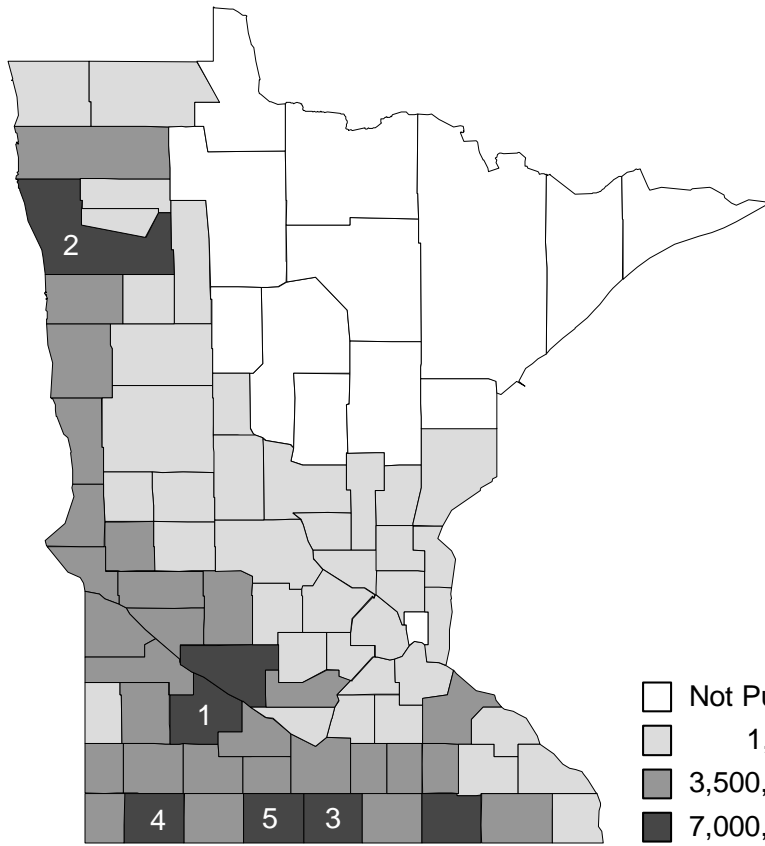
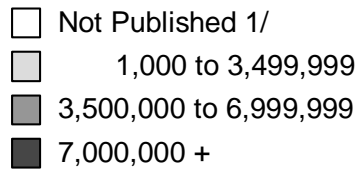


SOYBEANS Bushels Produced in 2007

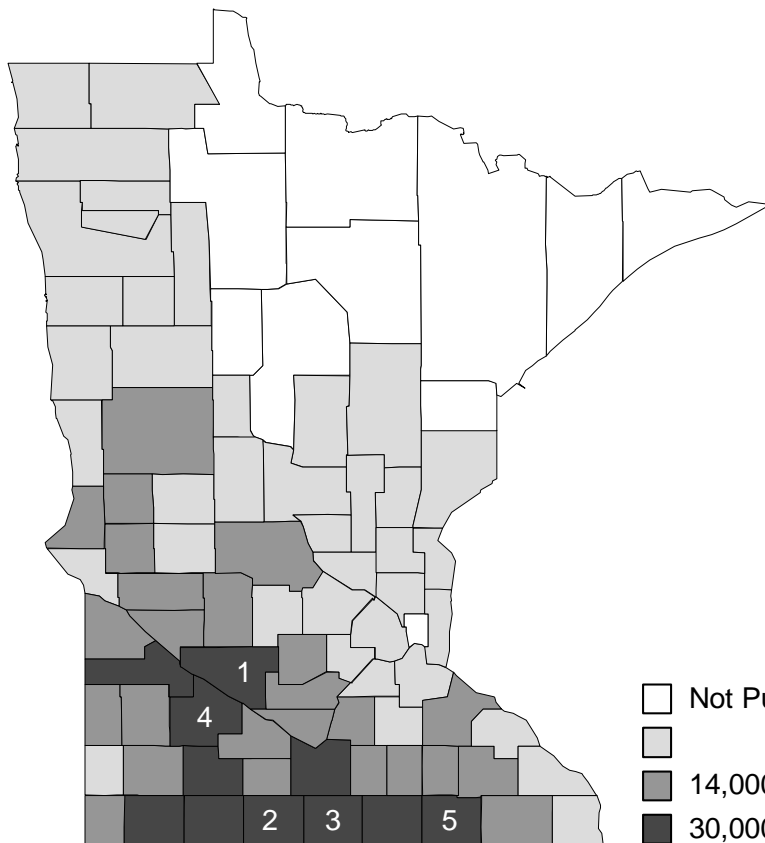

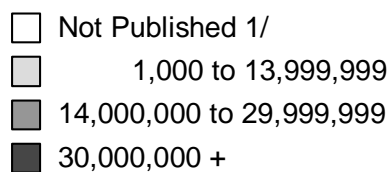


CORN Bushels Produced in 2007



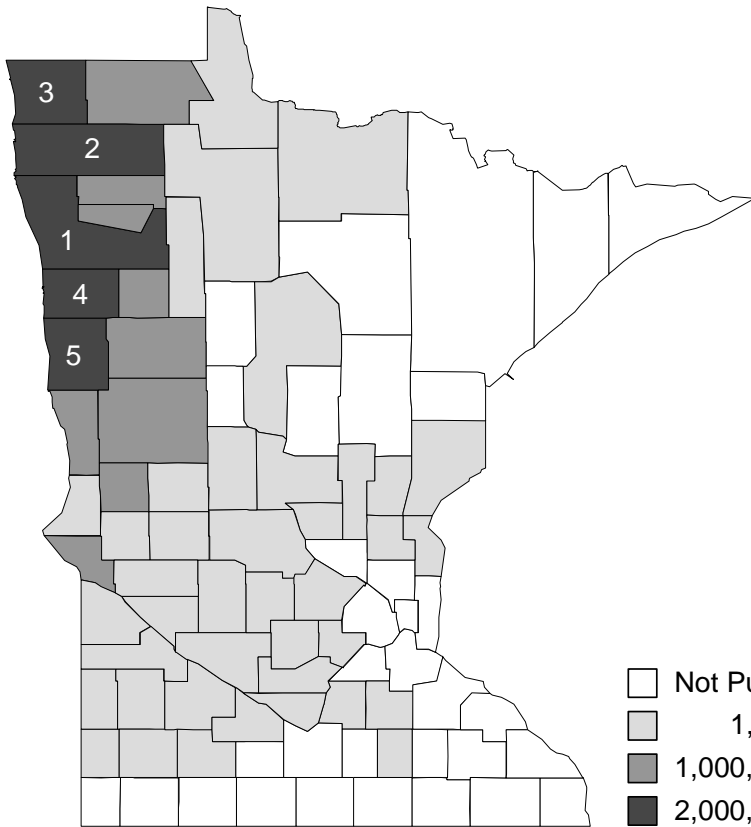

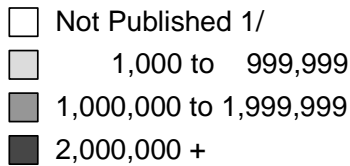

SPRING WHEAT Bushels Produced in 2007

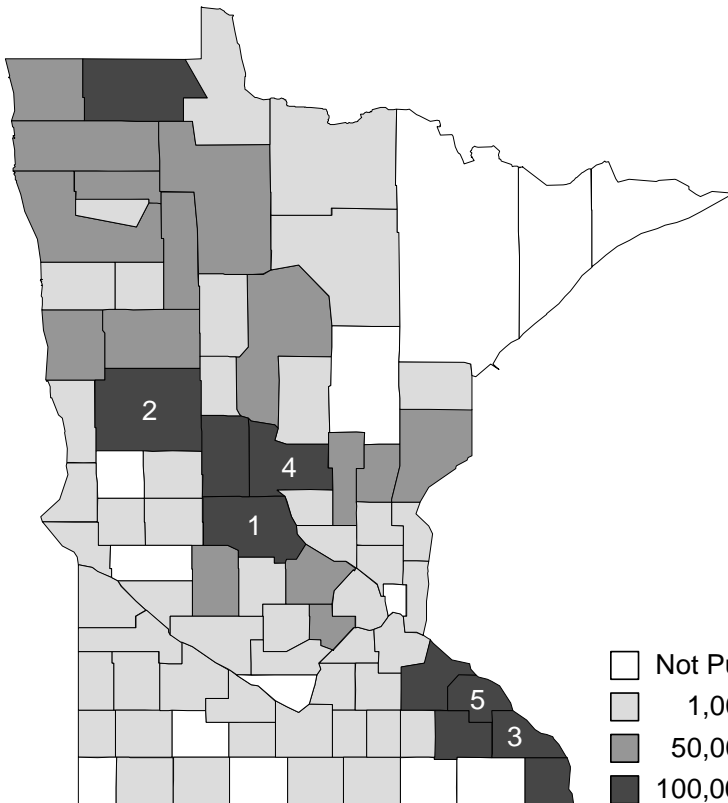

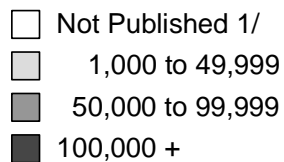


ALL HAY Tons Produced in 2007



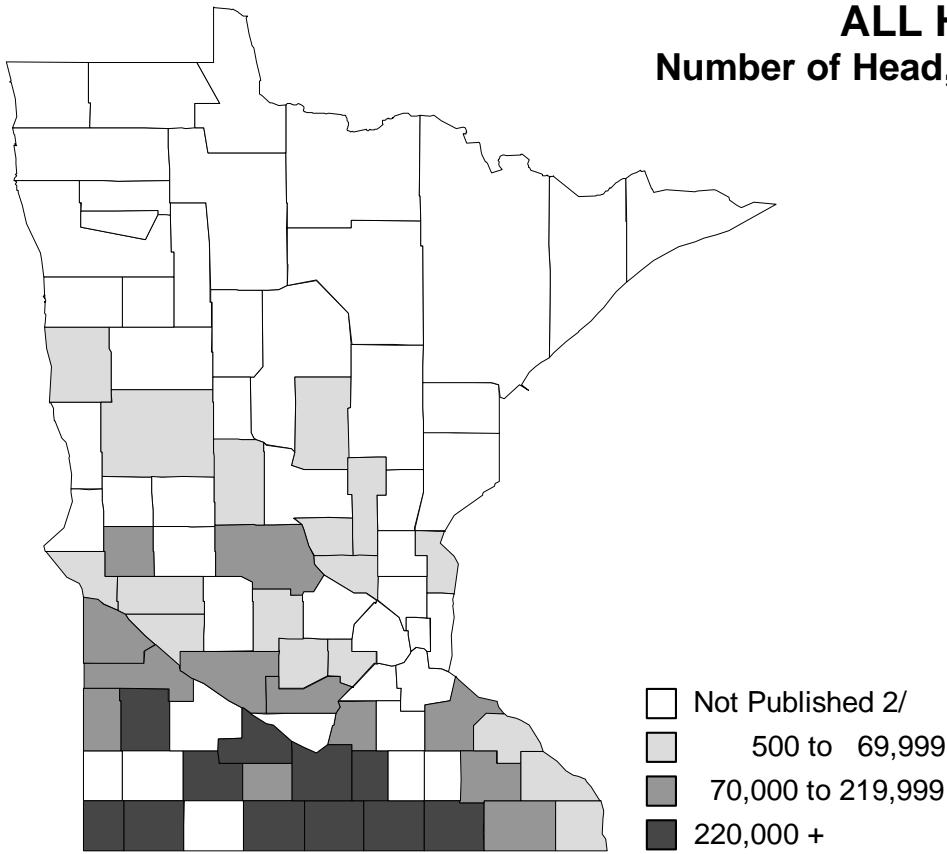

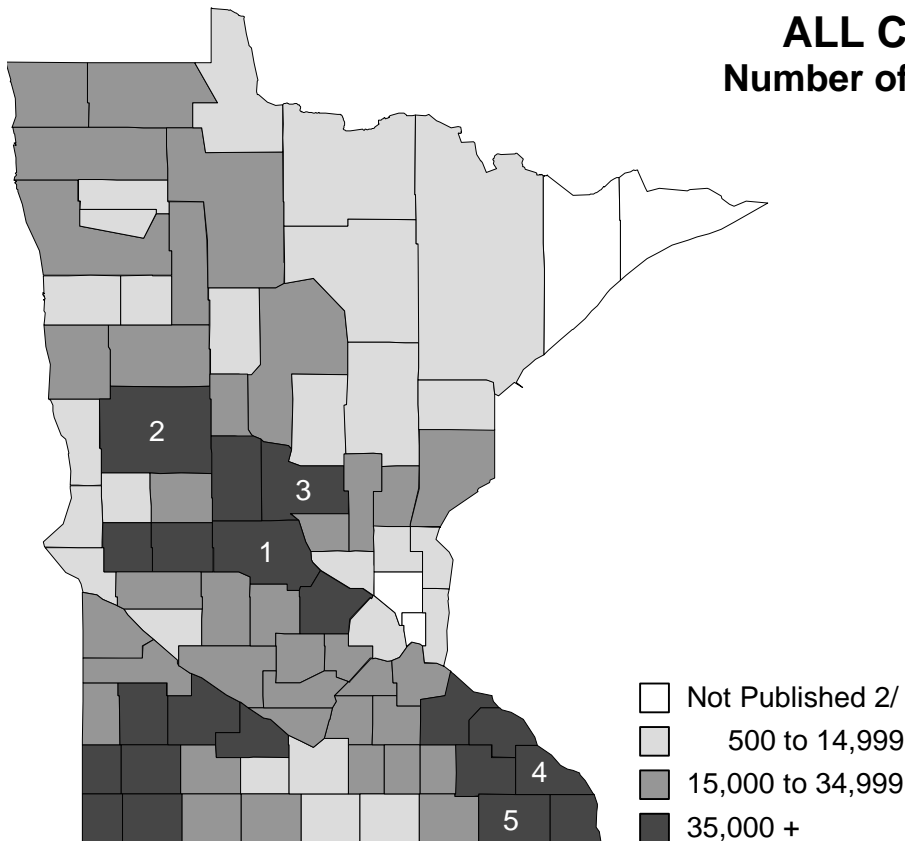

ALL CATTLE & CALVES Number of Head, January 1, 2008



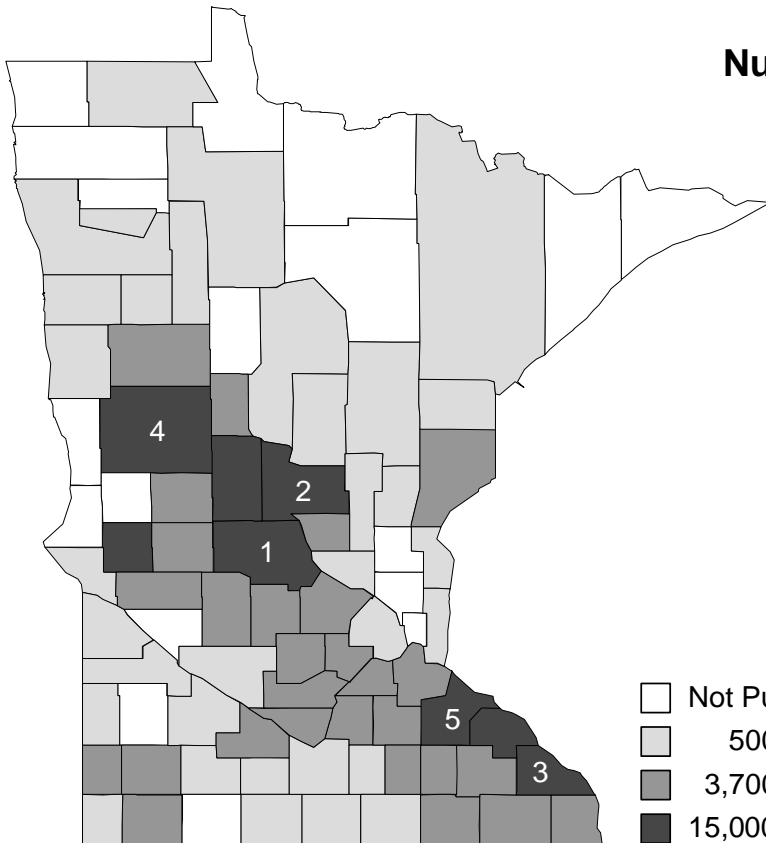

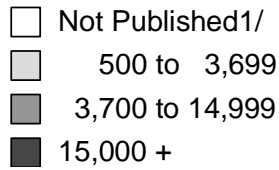
MILK COWS

Number of Head, January 1, 2008



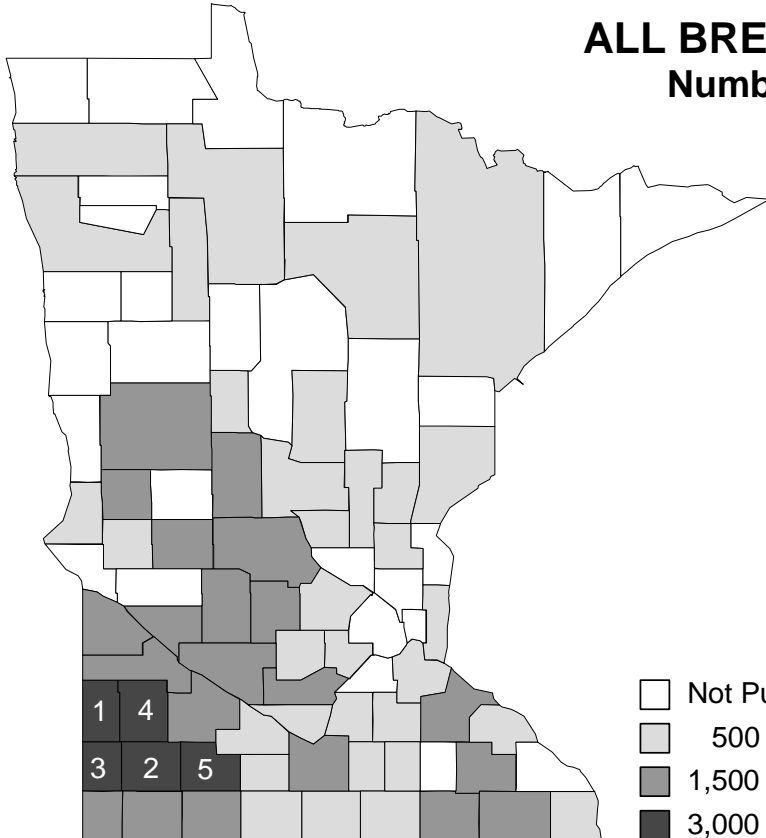

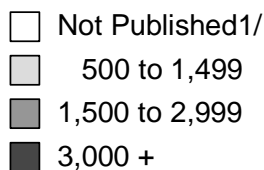
ALL BREEDING SHEEP AND LAMBS
