The average price received by farmers for **corn** during March 2024 in Minnesota was \$4.26 per bushel according to the latest USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service – Agricultural Prices report. This was 5 cents below the February price and \$2.21 below March 2023.

The March 2024 average price received by farmers for **soybeans**, at \$11.30 per bushel, was 20 cents below the February price and \$3.20 below the March 2023 price.

The March average spring wheat price per bushel, at \$6.49, was 39 cents below February and \$3.29 below March 2023.

All hay prices in Minnesota averaged \$144.00 per ton in March. This was \$1.00 below the February price and \$27.00 below the March 2023 price. The March 2024 alfalfa hay price, at \$152.00, was \$2.00 below the previous month and \$27.00 below March 2023. The average price received for other hay during March was \$115.00 per ton. This was \$11.00 below the February price and \$33.00 below March last year.

The average price for **milk** was \$19.50 per cwt, unchanged from the February price but \$1.50 below March 2023. Prices received for **milk cows** for dairy herd replacement averaged \$2,150 per head as of April 1, 2024.


