According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Mississippi, there were 5.0 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, November 13, 2022**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 6 percent very short, 25 percent short, 60 percent adequate, and 9 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 7 percent very short, 25 percent short, 58 percent adequate, and 10 percent surplus.
