2009 Missouri Corn Production



In 2009, Missouri ranked tenth in the nation in corn production.

In 2009, production for grain totaled 447 million bushels, with an average yield of 153 bushels per acre.

In 2009, corn for grain was produced from 3.00 million harvested acres and silage was cut on 50,000 acres.

In 2009, the total value of grain production was estimated at \$1.63 billion.

In 2009, the average price per bushel was \$3.65.

Missouri Corn Records

The record yield was set in 2004 with 162 bushels per acre.

The highest production on record was also set in 2004 with 466.6 million bushels.
