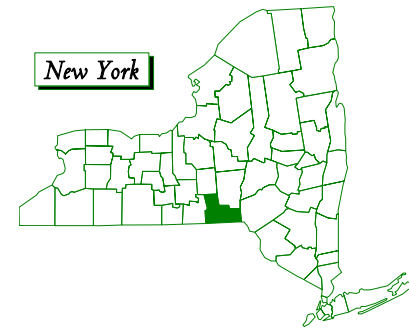

Broome County

Farm Statistics

August 2009

Broome County lies in the southern part of the state bordering Pennsylvania. In 2008, there were 86,613 acres in farms, 19 percent of the county's total 451,692 acres. There were 580 farms in the county averaging 149 acres per farm. Broome County ranks 35th in the state for number of farms and 38th for land in farms.

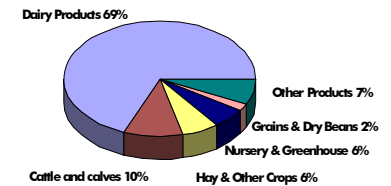
In 2007, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$29.8 million. Total sales averaged \$54,390 per farm. The leading products sold were: Milk & Dairy, Cattle & Calves, Hay, Nursery & Floriculture, and Grains & Dry Beans.

The average value of land and buildings per farm was \$275,676. Machinery and equipment was valued at \$62,296 per farm. Total production expenses in 2007 were \$24.4 million for an average of \$42,176 per farm. The Census showed 43 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 56.8 years. The U.S.D.A.'s Economic Research Service showed the median household income in 2007 was \$43,399.

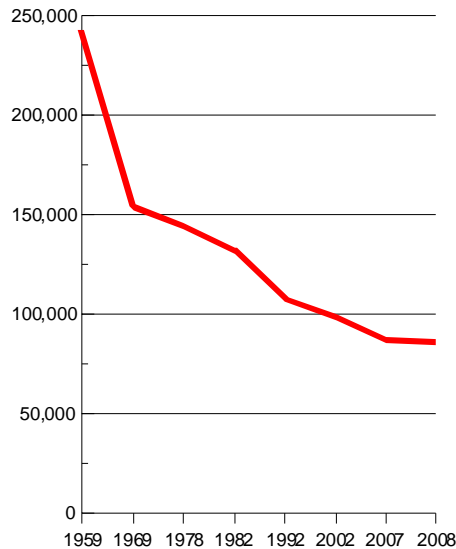

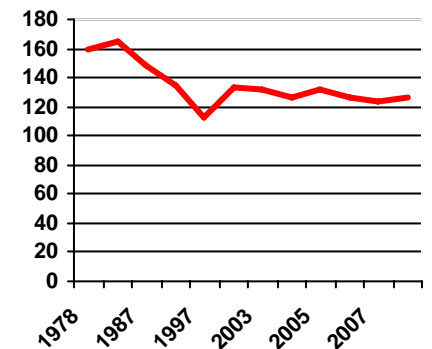
