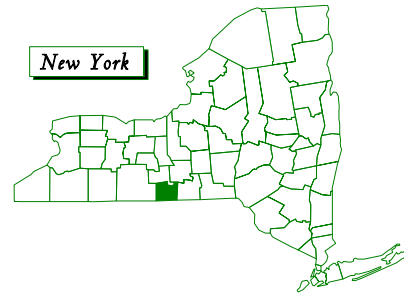

Farm Statistics

April 2009

Chemung county lies in the south central part of the state, also called the Southern Tier, bordering Pennsylvania. In 2008, there were 65,124 acres in farms, 25 percent of the county's total 260,712 acres. There were 373 farms in the county averaging 175 acres per farm. Chemung County ranks 46th in the state for number of farms and 44th for land in farms.

In 2007, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$16.6 million. Total sales averaged \$44,526 per farm. The leading products sold were: Milk & Dairy, Cattle & Calves, Grains & Dry Beans, Hay, and Vegetables & Potatoes.

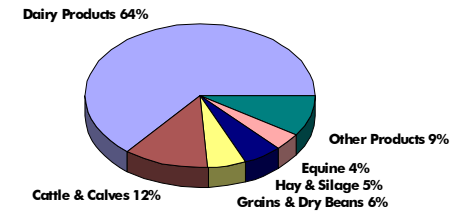
The average value of land and buildings per farm was \$319,539. Machinery and equipment was valued at \$69,729 per farm. Total production expenses in 2007 were \$16 million for an average of \$43,032 per farm. The Census showed 49 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 56.7 years. The U.S.D.A.'s Economic Research Service showed the median household income in 2007 was \$40,891.

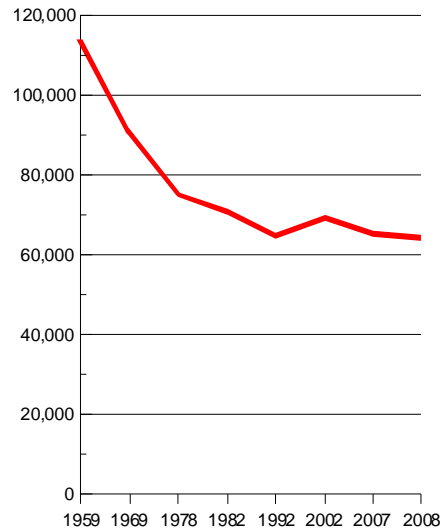

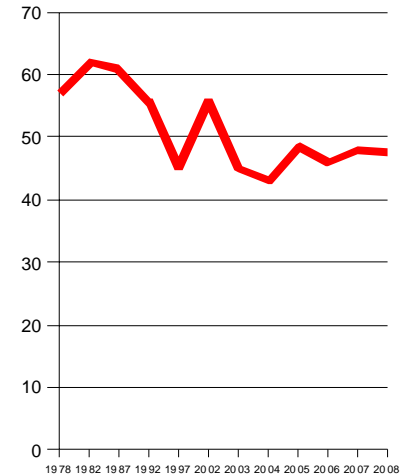
