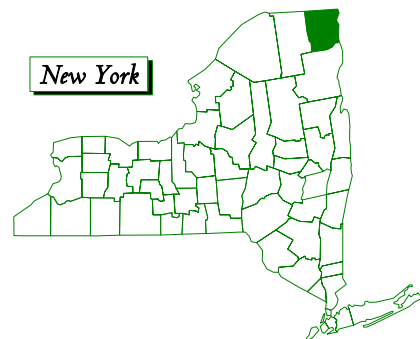

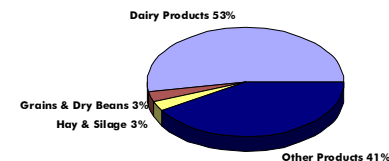
Clinton County lies in the north eastern part of the state bordering Canada and Lake Champlain. In 2008, there were 149,219 acres in farms, 23 percent of the county's total 664,236 acres. There were 590 farms in the county averaging 253 acres per farm. Clinton County ranks 30th in the state for number of farms and 22nd for land in farms.

In 2007, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$124.2million. Total sales averaged \$210,508 per farm. The leading products sold were: Milk & Dairy, Grains & Dry Beans, Hay, Nursery & Floriculture, and Horses & Mules.

The average value of land and buildings per farm was \$442,944. Machinery and equipment was valued at \$108,357 per farm. Total production expenses in 2007 were \$82.8 million for an average of \$140,368 per farm. The Census showed 56 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 54.9 years. The U.S.D.A.'s Economic Research Service showed the median household income in 2007 was \$45,462.

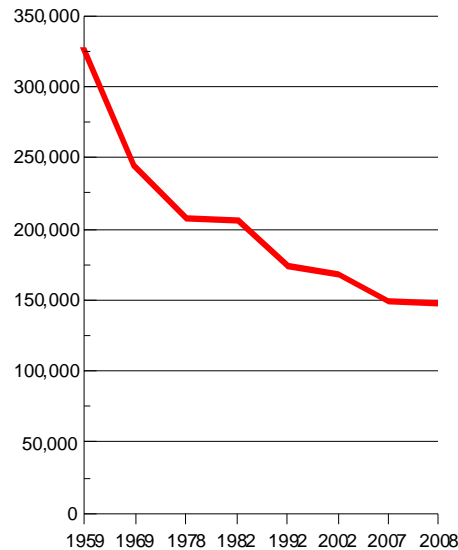

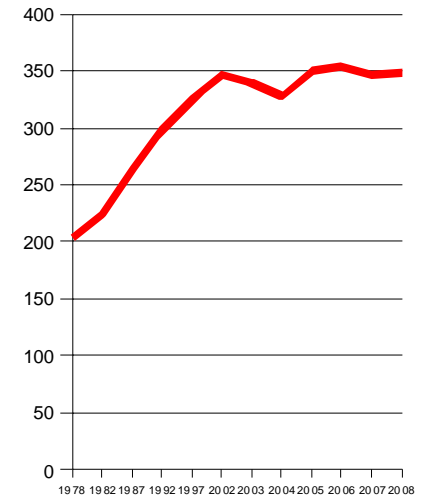
