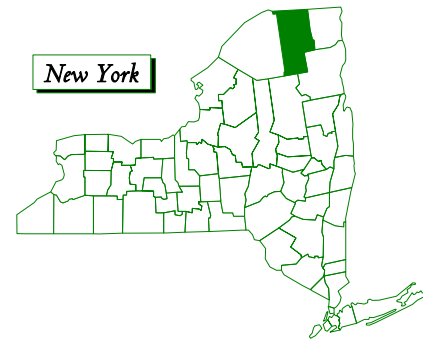

Farm Statistics

August 2009

Franklin County is located in the northern part of the state in the Adirondack Mountains bordering Canada. In 2008, there were 130,852 acres in farms, 13 percent of the county's total 1,042,626 acres. There were 604 farms in the county averaging 217 acres per farm. Franklin County ranks 28th in the state for number of farms and 27th for land in farms.

In 2007, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$68 million. Total sales averaged \$112,743 per farm. The leading products sold were: Milk & Dairy, Cattle & Calves, Hay, Vegetables & Potatoes, and Grains & Dry Beans.

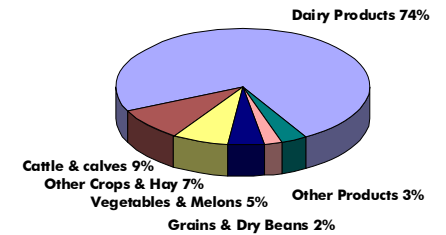
The average value of land and buildings per farm in 2007 was 314,833. Machinery and equipment were valued at \$83,318 per farm. Total production expenses in 2007 were \$50.2 million for an average of \$83,249 per farm. The Census showed 57 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 52.5 years. The U.S.D.A.'s Economic Research Service showed the median household income in 2007 was \$39,199.

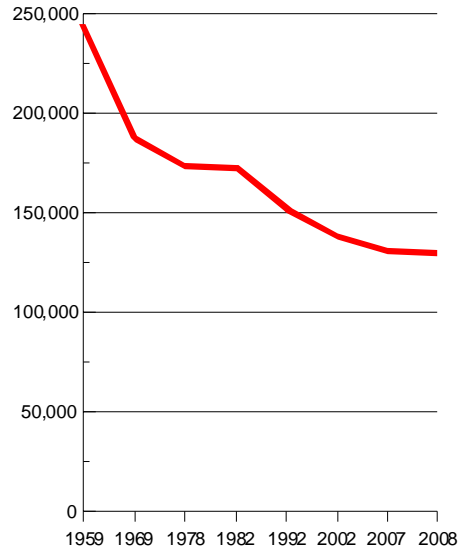

Land in Farms (Acres)

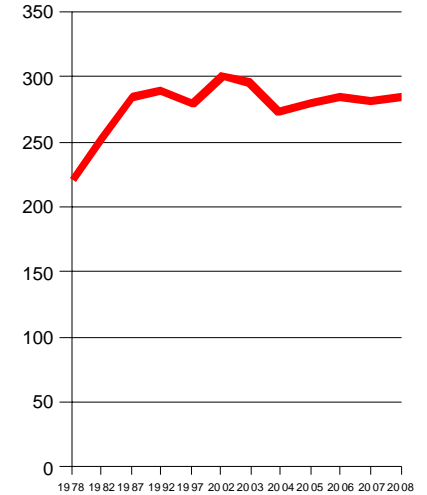
