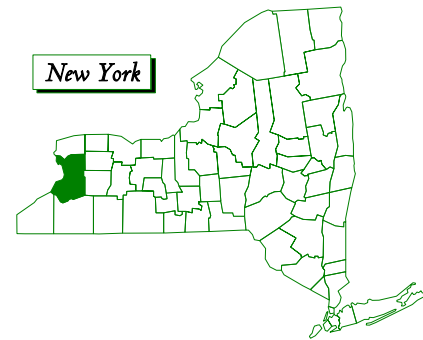

Farm Statistics

August 2009

Livingston County is located in the western part of New York State. In 2008, there were 222,415 acres in farms, 55 percent of the county's total 404,473 acres. There were 792 farms in the county averaging 281 acres per farm. Livingston County ranks 17th in the state for number of farms and 6th for land in farms.

In 2007, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$153.8 million. Total sales averaged \$194,243 per farm. The leading products sold were: Milk & Dairy, Grains & Dry Beans, Cattle & Calves, Vegetables & Potatoes, and Hay.

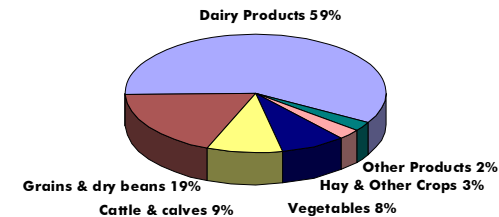
The average value of land and buildings per farm in 2007 was \$565,547. Machinery and equipment were valued at \$126,034 per farm. Total production expenses in 2007 were \$126.1 million for an average of \$159,251 per farm. The Census showed 53 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 57.2 years. The U.S.D.A.'s Economic Research Service showed the median household income in 2007 was \$49,927.

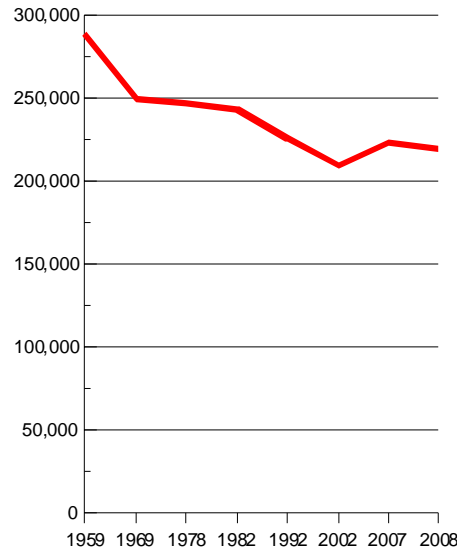
