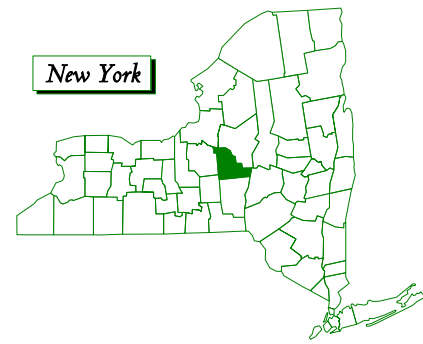

Madison County

Farm Statistics

August 2009

Madison County is located in the central part of New York State. In 2008, there were 188,320 acres in farms, 45 percent of the county's total 419,104 acres. There were 744 farms in the county averaging 253 acres per farm. Madison County ranks 20th in the state for number of farms and 11th for land in farms.

In 2007, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$86.3 million. Total sales averaged \$116,036 per farm. The leading products sold were: Milk & Dairy, Cattle & Calves, Grains & Dry Beans, Nursery & Floriculture, and Hay.

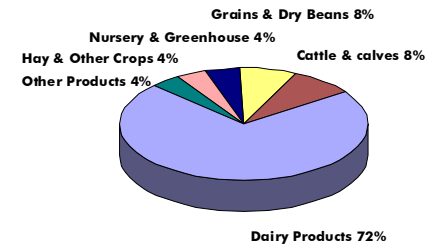
The average value of land and buildings per farm in 2007 was \$425,987. Machinery and equipment were valued at \$113,067 per farm. Total production expenses in 2007 were \$67.8 million for an average of \$91,230 per farm. The Census showed 56 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 55.7 years. The U.S.D.A.'s Economic Research Service showed the median household income in 2007 was \$50,924.

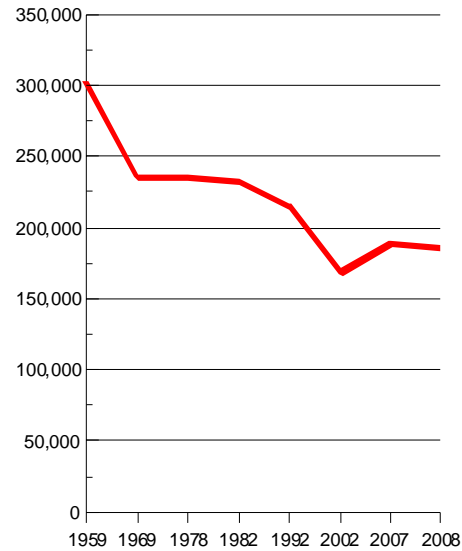
