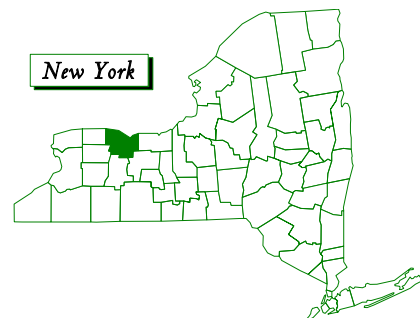

Farm Statistics

August 2009

Monroe County lies in the northwest part of the State bordering Lake Ontario. In 2008, there were 133,041 acres in farms, 32 percent of the county's total 420,637 acres. There were 585 farms in the county averaging 227 acres per farm. Monroe County ranks 33rd in the state for number of farms and 26th for land in farms.

In 2007, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$72.2 million. Total sales averaged \$123,436 per farm. The leading products sold were: Grains & Dry Beans, Vegetables & Potatoes, Nursery & Floriculture, Milk & Dairy, and Fruits & Nuts.

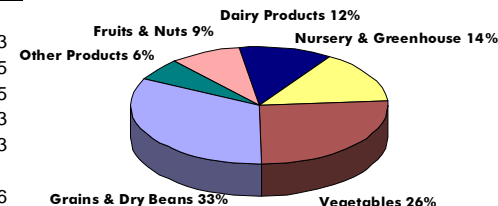
The average value of land and buildings per farm in 2007 was \$587,711. Machinery and equipment were valued at \$106,178 per farm. Total production expenses in 2007 were \$57.7 million for an average of \$98,678 per farm. The Census showed 55 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 57.6 years. The U.S.D.A.'s Economic Research Service showed the median household income in 2007 was \$50,050.

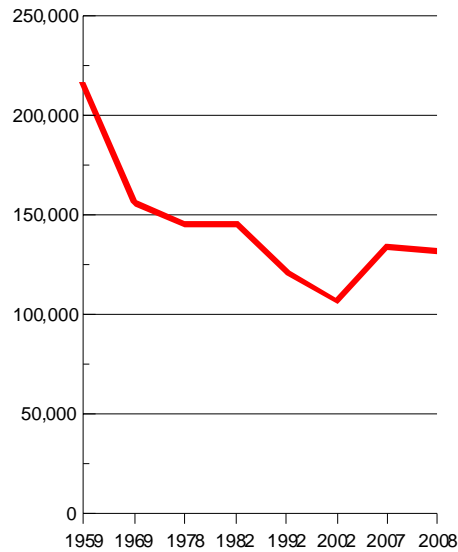
