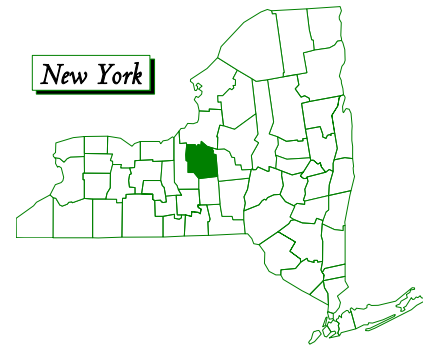

Farm Statistics

August 2009

Onondaga County is located in central New York. In 2008, there were 150,499 acres in farms, 31 percent of the county's total 498,174 acres. There were 692 farms in the county averaging 217 acres per farm. Onondaga County ranks 21st in the state for number of farms and 20th for land in farms.

In 2007, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$137.3 million. Total sales averaged \$198,515 per farm. The leading products sold were: Milk & Dairy, Fruits & Nuts, Poultry & Eggs, Grains & Dry Beans, and Cattle & Calves.

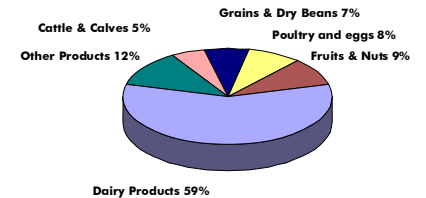
The average value of land and buildings per farm in 2007 was \$521,122. Machinery and equipment were valued at \$127,052 per farm. Total production expenses in 2007 were \$100.1 million for an average of \$44,785 per farm. The Census showed 54 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 56 years. The U.S.D.A.'s Economic Research Service showed the median household income in 2007 was \$48,807.

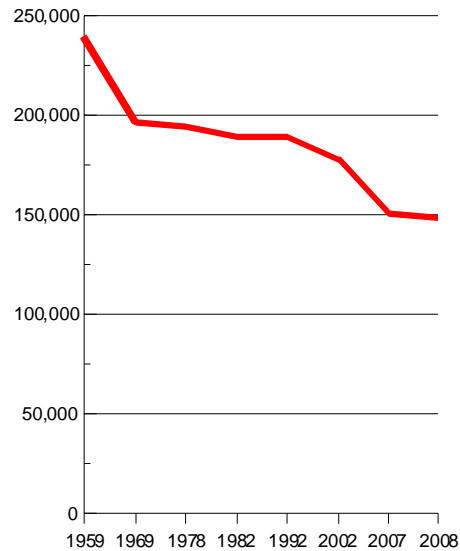
