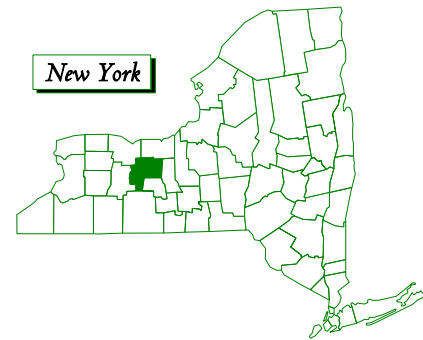

Farm Statistics

August 2009

Ontario County is located in the Finger Lakes Region of west central New York. In 2008, there were 198,937 acres in farms, 48 percent of the county's total 412,381 acres. There were 859 farms in the county averaging 232 acres per farm. Ontario County ranks 14th in the state for number of farms and 9th for land in farms.

In 2007, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$153.8 million. Total sales averaged \$179,101 per farm. The leading products sold were: Milk & Dairy, Grains & Dry Beans, Vegetables & Potatoes, Cattle & Calves, and Fruits & Nuts.

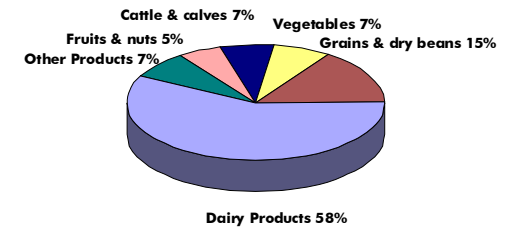
The average value of land and buildings per farm in 2007 was \$510,387. Machinery and equipment were valued at \$127,424 per farm. Total production expenses in 2007 were \$116.8 million for an average of \$136,045 per farm. The Census showed 54 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 54.2 years. The U.S.D.A.'s Economic Research Service showed the median household income in 2007 was \$54,107.

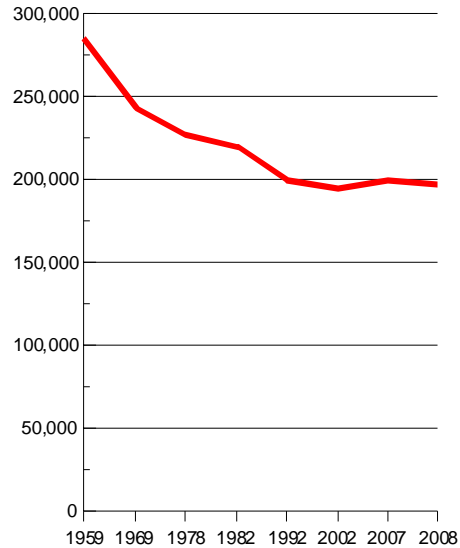
