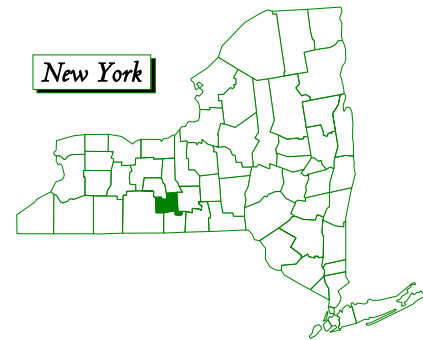

Farm Statistics

August 2009

Schuyler County is located in the west central part of New York in the Finger Lakes region. In 2008, there were 66,368 acres in farms, 32 percent of the county's total 210,429 acres. There were 394 farms in the county averaging 168 acres per farm. Schuyler County ranks 45th in the state for number of farms and 43rd for land in farms.

In 2007, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$33 million. Total sales averaged \$83,907 per farm. The leading products sold were: Milk & Dairy, Fruits & Nuts, Grains & Dry Beans, Cattle & Calves, and Hay.

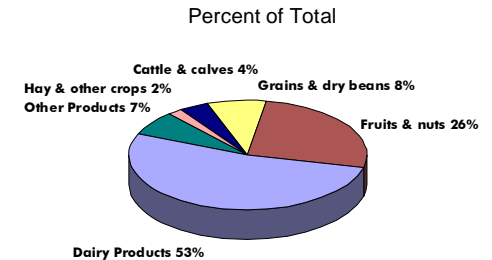
The average value of land and buildings per farm in 2007 was \$366,960. Machinery and equipment were valued at \$67,088 per farm. Total production expenses in 2007 were \$23.5 million for an average of \$59,776 per farm. The Census showed 56 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 56.9 years. The U.S.D.A.'s Economic Research Service showed the median household income in 2007 was \$44,511.

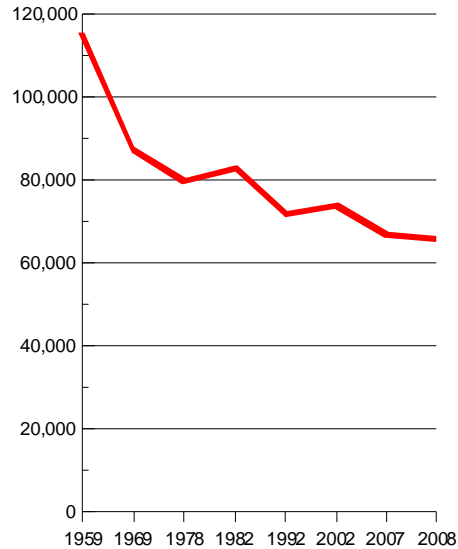
