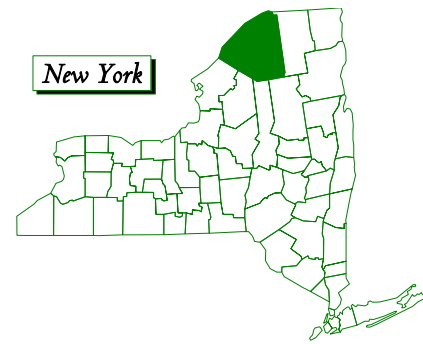

Farm Statistics

August 2009

St. Lawrence County is located in northern New York bordering the St. Lawrence River and Canada. In 2008, there were 347,246 acres in farms, 20 percent of the county's total 1,715,456 acres. There were 1,330 farms in the county averaging 261 acres per farm. St. Lawrence County ranks 3rd in the state for number of farms and 2nd for land in farms.

In 2007, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$140.1 million. Total sales averaged \$105,377 per farm. The leading products sold were: Milk & Dairy, Cattle & Calves, Hay, Grains & Dry Beans, and Vegetables & Potatoes.

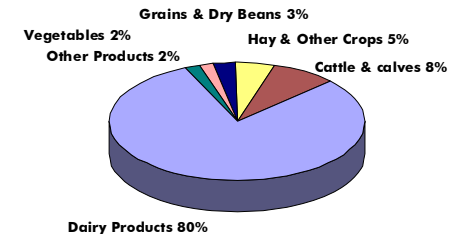
The average value of land and buildings per farm in 2007 was \$351,391. Machinery and equipment were valued at \$81,940 per farm. Total production expenses in 2007 were \$106.9 million for an average of \$80,441 per farm. The Census showed 61 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 55.5 years. The U.S.D.A.'s Economic Research Service showed the median household income in 2007 was \$39,035.

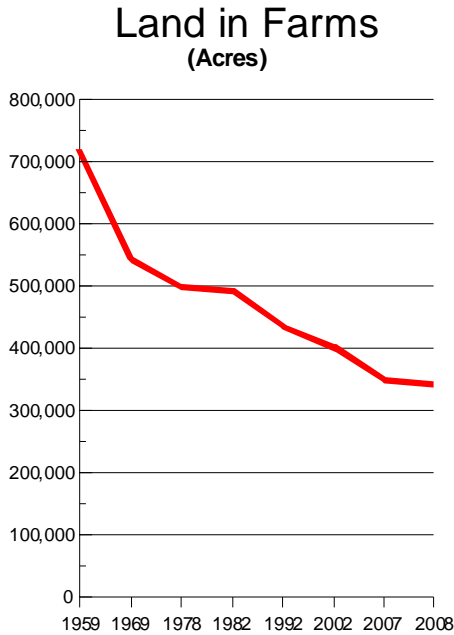

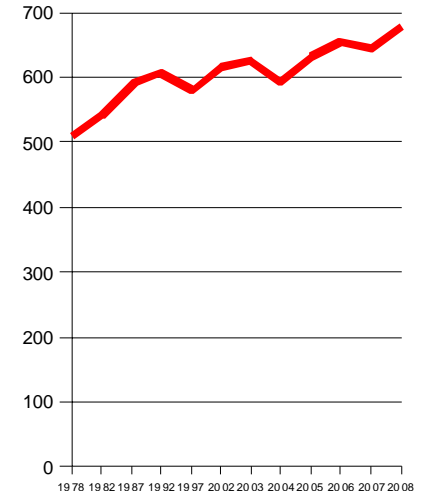
