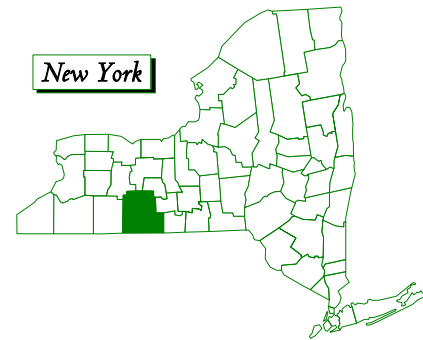

Farm Statistics

August 2009

Steuben County is located in the southern tier of New York bordering Pennsylvania. In 2008, there were 371,932 acres in farms, 42 percent of the county's total 889,972 acres. There were 1578 farms in the county averaging 236 acres per farm. Steuben County ranks 2nd in the state for number of farms and 1st for land in farms.

In 2007, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$135.2 million. Total sales averaged \$85,732 per farm. The leading products sold were: Milk & Dairy, Cattle & Calves, Vegetables & Potatoes, Grains & Dry Beans, and Hay.

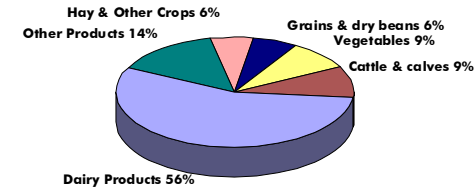
The average value of land and buildings per farm in 2007 was \$370,465. Machinery and equipment were valued at \$88,340 per farm. Total production expenses in 2007 were \$102.9 million for an average of \$65,267 per farm. The Census showed 49 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 56.8 years. The U.S.D.A.'s Economic Research Service showed the median household income in 2007 was \$41,519.

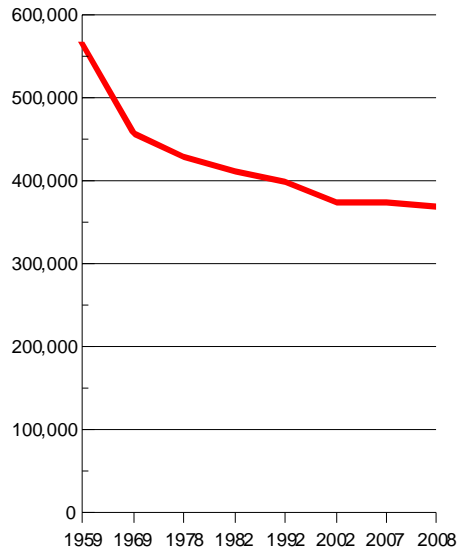
