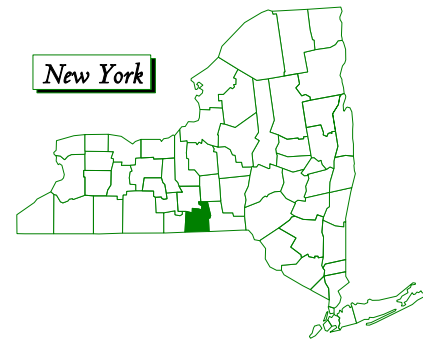

Farm Statistics

August 2009

Tioga County is located in the southern tier of New York State, bordering Pennsylvania. In 2008, there were 106,834 acres in farms, 32 percent of the county's total 331,940 acres. There were 565 farms in the county averaging 189 acres per farm. Tioga County ranks 36th in the state for number of farms and 33rd for land in farms.

In 2007, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$36.6 million. Total sales averaged \$64,894 per farm. The leading products sold were: Milk & Dairy, Hay, Nursery & Floriculture, Other Animals & Animal Products, and Grains & Dry Beans.

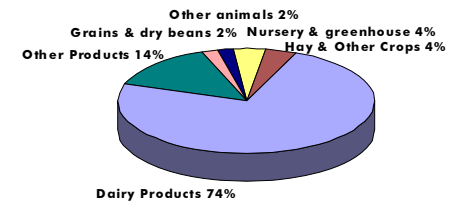
The average value of land and buildings per farm in 2007 was \$331,150. Machinery and equipment were valued at \$70,301 per farm. Total production expenses in 2007 were \$28 million for an average of \$49,750 per farm. The Census showed 44 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 58.5 years. The U.S.D.A.'s Economic Research Service showed the median household income in 2007 was \$49,235.

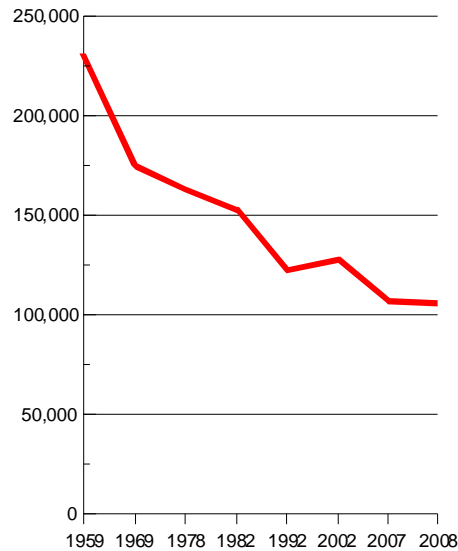

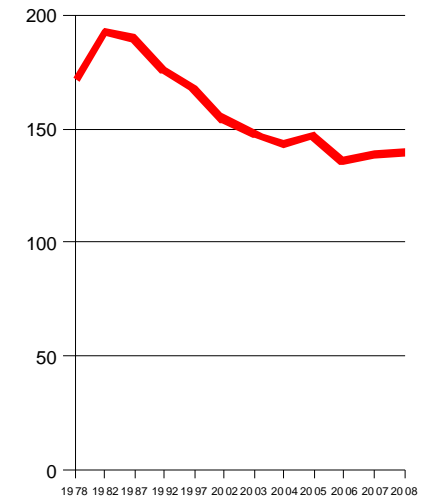
