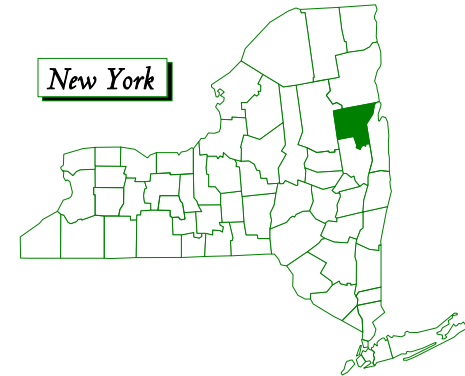

# Warren County Farm Statistics

August 2009

Warren County is located in the Adirondack Mountains in northeastern New York. In 2008, there were 8,555 acres in farms, 2 percent of the county's total 554,853 acres. There were 86 farms in the county averaging 99 acres per farm. Warren County ranks 53<sup>rd</sup> in the state for number of farms and 52<sup>nd</sup> for land in farms.

The leading products sold were: Other Animals & Animal Products, Hay, Cattle & Calves, Poultry & Eggs, and Vegetables & Potatoes.

The average value of land and buildings per farm in 2007 was \$345,406. Machinery and equipment were valued at \$45,201 per farm. Total production expenses in 2007 were \$7 million for an average of \$81,629 per farm. The Census showed 37 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 57.5 years. The U.S.D.A.'s Economic Research Service showed the median household income in 2007 was \$47,043.

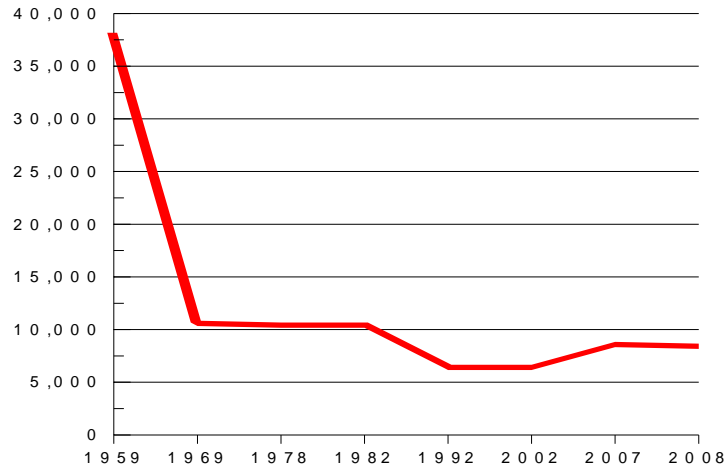
