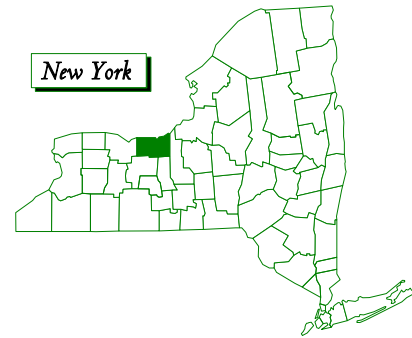

Wayne County

Farm Statistics August 2009

Wayne County is located on the southern shore of Lake Ontario in North Western New York. In 2008, there were 168,471 acres in farms, 44 percent of the county's total 386,826 acres. There were 938 farms in the county averaging 180 acres per farm. Wayne County ranks 8th in the state for number of farms and 16th for land in farms.

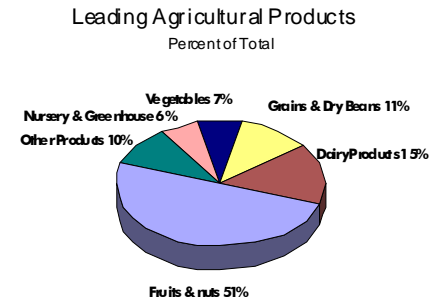
In 2007, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$168.9 million. Total sales averaged \$180,131 per farm. The leading products sold were: Fruits & Nuts, Milk & Dairy, Grains & Dry Beans, Vegetables & Potatoes, and Nursery & Floriculture.

The average value of land and buildings per farm in 2007 was \$410,385. Machinery and equipment were valued at \$125,569 per farm. Total production expenses in 2007 were \$117.9 million for an average of \$125,716 per farm. The Census showed 59 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 56.2 years. The U.S.D.A.'s Economic Research Service showed the median household income in 2007 was \$51,853.

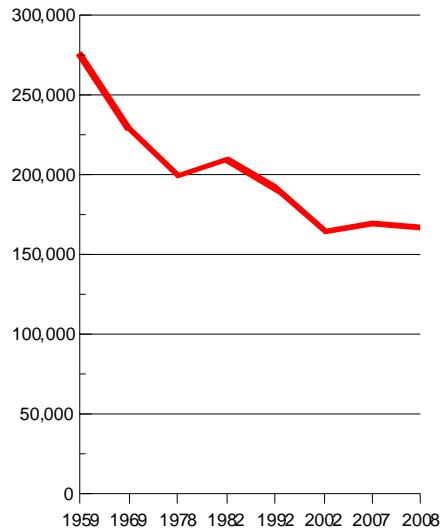

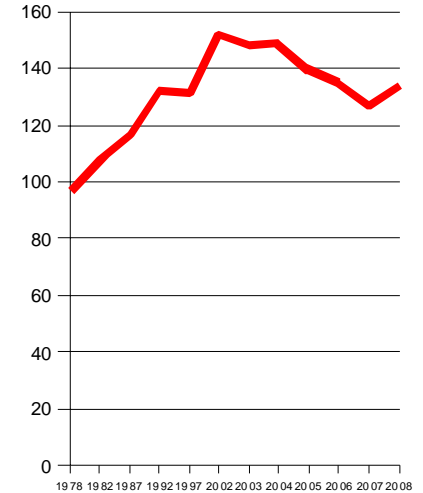
