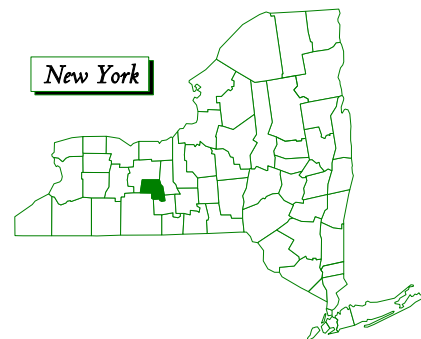

Farm Statistics

August 2009

Yates County is located in west central New York in the Finger Lakes region. In 2008, there were 126,118 acres in farms, 58 percent of the county's total 216,392 acres. There were 864 farms in the county averaging 146 acres per farm. Yates County ranks 13th in the state for number of farms and 29th for land in farms.

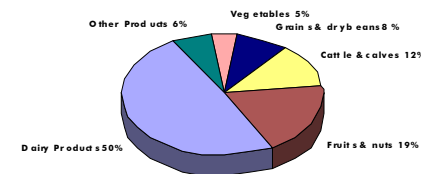
In 2007, according to the Census of Agriculture, the market value of all agricultural products sold from county farms was \$88.3 million. Total sales averaged \$102,294 per farm. The leading products sold were: Milk & Dairy, Fruits & Nuts, Cattle & Calves, Grains & Dry Beans, and Vegetables & Potatoes.

The average value of land and buildings per farm in 2007 was \$415,303. Machinery and equipment were valued at \$92,975 per farm. Total production expenses in 2007 were \$61 million for an average of \$70,682 per farm. The Census showed 64 percent of the farm operators reported farming as their principal occupation. The average age of the operator was 49.9 years. The U.S.D.A.'s Economic Research Service showed the median household income in 2007 was \$40,924.

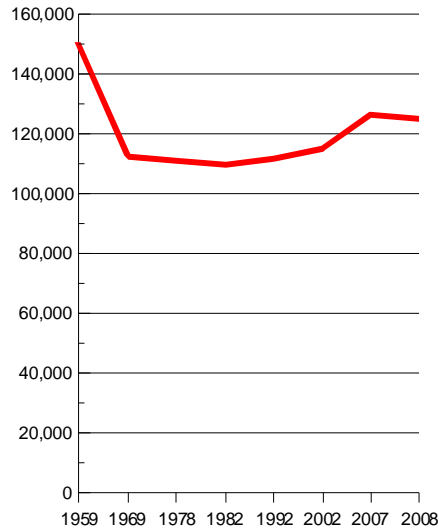
