## **North Dakota Data Products**

***North Dakota Agricultural Statistics:*** Issued annually in July. Comprehensive book of state/county agricultural statistics. Available by mail subscription (\$11.00 or complimentary to farm operators) and updated each July on the Internet.

***North Dakota Crop, Livestock & Weather:*** Released weekly April through November; monthly December to March. Reports crop progress and conditions, weather and farm activities. Available by mail subscription (\$12.00/year), e-mail subscription (free) and kept current on the Internet.

***North Dakota Farm Reporter:*** Issued biweekly (24/year). Includes up-to-date state and national agricultural data. Available by mail subscription (\$10.00/year) and on the Internet.

***News Releases:*** Printed copies available to news media only. Available free by e-mail subscription to the public and kept current on the Internet.

***2007 Census of Agriculture:*** Comprehensive state and national data about production agriculture. Available by mail and on the Internet.

***Other publications:*** *North Dakota County Rents & Values; North Dakota's Rank in Agriculture; North Dakota Wheat and Barley Varieties; North Dakota Custom Rates; and North Dakota at a Glance.* Printed copies are free upon request. Also available on the Internet.

## **GIS-Based Products**

### ***North Dakota Land Use Stratification***

Data and map products available showing North Dakota Land use. Cropland strata distinguished by amount of land cultivated.

### ***Normalized Difference Vegetative Images***

Regional, biweekly AVHRR-NDVI Satellite map products depicting actual and comparative vegetative differences from period-to-period, year-to-year.

### ***North Dakota Land Use Classification***

Computer classification of crop acreage and land use utilizing satellite imagery. Digitized data set and map products.

## **2007 Census of Agriculture Data Products**

Every five years, the census of agriculture snaps a picture of America's farm and ranch industry at the county, state, and national levels. As the prime source of consistent, comparable, detailed data about production agriculture, census data provide a basis for determining both the present state of agriculture and trends over time. ### **Volume 1, Geographic Area Series**

***United States, State and County Data*** - The United States Summary provides national data and selected data for each state. Separate state reports display statistics for the entire state and every county.

### **Volume 2, Subject Series**

***ZIP Code and Congressional District Tabulations*** - Presents agricultural statistics by five-digit postal ZIP Code and Congressional district in two separate files, for all farms in all 50 states.

***Agricultural Atlas of the United States*** - Features a series of maps highlighting agricultural activities and characteristics.

***Watershed Tabulations*** - Presents agricultural statistics by 6-digit Hydrological Unit Code for the contiguous 48 states, Alaska and Hawaii.

***Census of Agriculture History*** - Provides a description of the planning and conduct of the 2007 Census of Agriculture. Explains the history of the agriculture census, farm definition, data collection and processing, data dissemination, research, and the census of agriculture in outlying areas.

### **Volume 3, Special Studies**

***2008 Farm and Ranch Irrigation Survey*** - Displays results from a sample survey of farm and ranch operators who reported using irrigation in the 2007 census. Scheduled to be released February 2010.

***2009 Organic Production Survey*** - Provides data on organic agriculture to determine how the growth of organic farming is changing the face of U.S. agriculture. Scheduled to be released January 2010.

***2008 American Indian Reservations Survey*** - Presents a thorough report of statistics and demographic data on American Indian reservations.
