Oklahoma hatcheries set 7.51 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 3, up 1 percent from the week prior but down 4 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 18.7 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 3, up 1 percent from the week prior but down slightly from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 3, was 4.59 million, up 12 percent from the previous week and up 26 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of June 3, was 15.1 million, up 2 percent from the previous week and up slightly from the previous year.
