This report contains the results from the March 2023 Hog and Pig Survey. Data provided by Oklahoma and Texas producers are the foundation of the estimates made for the Southern Plains region. We would like to thank all producers who responded to the survey. Results from the next quarterly survey will be made available June 29, 2023.

#### **Oklahoma Highlights**

The March 1, 2023 Oklahoma hog and pig inventory, at 2.11 million head, was 1 percent higher than March 2022. The number of **breeding hogs** totaled 480 thousand head, up 10 thousand from last year. The March 1 **market hog** inventory was up 1 percent from a year ago at 1.63 million head, 77 percent of the total hog and pig inventory.


The December 2022-February 2023 Oklahoma **pig crop** totaled 2.08 million head, 11 percent above last year. Pigs per litter averaged 10.2, up 5 percent from the previous year. Sows farrowed during December 2022 through February 2023 totaled 205 thousand head, up 5 percent from last year.

#### **Texas Highlights**

The March 1, 2023 Texas hog and pig inventory, at 1.18 million head, was 13 percent higher than March 2022. The number of **breeding hogs** totaled 170 thousand head, up 10 thousand from last year. The March 1 **market hog** inventory was up 15 percent from a year ago at 1.01 million head, 86 percent of the total hog and pig inventory.

The December 2022-February 2023 Texas **pig crop** totaled 832 thousand head, 25 percent above last year. Pigs per litter averaged 11.4, up 8 percent from the previous year. Sows farrowed during December 2022 through February 2023 totaled 73.0 thousand head, up 16 percent from last year.

Hogs and Pigs: Inventory Number by Class and Weight Group, Oklahoma, Texas and United States 2022 - 23





#### **U.S. Highlights**

The U.S. inventory of all hogs and pigs on March 1, 2023, is estimated at 72.9 million head, up slightly from a year ago but down 2 percent from December 1, 2022. The **breeding hog inventory**, at 6.13 million head, was up slightly from last year but down slightly from the previous quarter. **Market hog** inventory, at 66.7 million head, was up slightly from last year but down 2 percent from last quarter.

The U.S. **pig crop** for December 2022-February 2023, at 32.1 million, was up slightly from 2022. U.S. producers intend to have 2.93 million sows farrow during the March 2023-May 2023 period, down 1 percent from the actual farrowings during the same period last year. Intended farrowings for June 2023-August 2023, at 2.97 million sows, are down 3 percent from the same quarter the year prior.
