










GOT MILK?

Which milk cow is different



Pennsylvania dairy farms produce about 1.2 billion gallons of milk every year. It takes 10-20 minutes to milk a cow. Most cows are milked twice a day. When milk leaves the cow, it is 101 degrees. It quickly is cooled to 40 degrees. On an average, most milk is sold at retail within 50 to 100 miles from the farm it was produced.
