

# Taking a Survey




## One, two, three, four!

You are counting. A SURVEY is a count. The Pennsylvania Field Office of USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service counts livestock (*cows, pigs, sheep, chickens*) and crops (*corn, oats, wheat, hay, soybeans, potatoes, fruits, vegetables*).

We need counts of livestock and crops. A survey answers big questions!
