H oney production for 1998 by producers with 5 or more hives totaled 1.5 million pounds. H oney producers took honey from 23,000 colonies, with an average yield of 66 pounds per colony. H oney stocks on hand as of December 15th were 698,000 pounds.

H oney producers received an average price of $\$ .80$ per pound for the 1998 crop.

The 1998 honey production is valued at $1,214,000$ dollars. Pennsylvania ranks 24th in the nation for honey production.

A sample of honey producers were surveyed in December for information on number of colonies, honey production, honey stocks on hand for sale, and prices received for honey sold.
