AUSTIN . . . According to the Texas Field Office, the second-quarter **wheat** stocks for Texas were up 16 percent from last year. Stocks in all positions on December 1 totaled 64.3 million bushels. The on-farm wheat storage, at 1.8 million bushels, was down from the 3.0 million bushels stored on farms a year ago. Off-farm wheat stocks, at 62.5 million bushels, accounted for 97 percent of all wheat stocks.

All **sorghum** stocks in all positions for Texas totaled 33.5 million cwt on December 1, up 29 percent from the previous year. On-farm stocks totaled 1.6 million cwt was down 38 percent from a year ago. Off-farm sorghum stocks, at 31.9 million cwt, accounted for 95 percent of all sorghum stocks.

U.S. **corn** stocks in all positions on December 1, 2005, totaled 9.81 billion bushels, up 4 percent from December 1, 2004. **All wheat** stocks in all positions on December 1, totaled 1.43 billion bushels, down slightly from a year ago. **Grain sorghum** in all positions totaled 162 million cwt, up 2 percent from December 1, 2004. **Soybeans** stored in all positions on December 1, 2005, totaled 2.50 billion bushels, up 9 percent from December 1, 2004. **Oats** in all positions totaled 95.7 million bushels, down 9 percent from December 1, 2004.
