AUSTIN . . . According to the Texas Field Office, the second-quarter **wheat** stocks for Texas were down 17 percent from last year. Stocks in all positions on December 1 totaled 53.1 million bushels. The on-farm wheat storage, at 1.5 million bushels, was down from the 1.8 million bushels stored on farms a year ago. Off-farm wheat stocks, at 51.6 million bushels, accounted for 97 percent of all wheat stocks.

All **sorghum** stocks in all positions for Texas totaled 18.8 million cwt on December 1, down 44 percent from the previous year. On-farm stocks totaled 1.4 million cwt was down 14 percent from a year ago. Off-farm sorghum stocks, at 17.4 million cwt, accounted for 93 percent of all sorghum stocks.

U.S. **corn** stocks in all positions on December 1, 2006, totaled 8.93 billion bushels, down 9 percent from December 1, 2005. **All wheat** stocks in all positions on December 1, totaled 1.31 billion bushels, down 8 percent from a year ago. **Grain sorghum** in all positions totaled 116 million cwt, down 29 percent from December 1, 2005. **Soybeans** stored in all positions on December 1, 2006, totaled 2.70 billion bushels, up 8 percent from December 1, 2005. **Oats** in all positions totaled 96.2 million bushels, up 1 percent from December 1, 2005.
