UNCHANGED FROM LAST YEAR

AUSTIN . . . . Texas milk production totaled 569 million pounds during February, unchanged from last year's production of 569 million pounds. January 2007 production totaled 618 million pounds.

The number of milk cows during February averaged 347 head, up 19,000 head from last year and unchanged from the January 2007 number. Production per cow averaged 1,640 pounds during February, 95 pounds less than last year and 140 pounds less than January 2007.

Milk production in the 23 states participating in the monthly survey totaled 13.1 billion pounds, up 0.9 percent from production in these same states in February 2006. January revised production, at 14.3 billion pounds, was up 1.8 percent from January 2006.

Production per cow during February averaged 1,586 pounds, unchanged from a year ago. The average number of milk cows in the 23 states was 8.28 million head, 71,000 head more than last year but 3,000 head less than January 2007.
