UNCHANGED FROM LAST YEAR

AUSTIN . . . . Texas milk production totaled 606 million pounds during June, unchanged from last year's production. May 2007 production totaled 649 million pounds.

The number of milk cows during June averaged 348,000 head, up 15,000 head from last year and up 1,000 head from the May 2007 number. Production per cow averaged 1,740 pounds during June, 80 pounds less than last year.

Milk production in the 23 states participating in the monthly survey totaled 14.2 billion pounds, up 1.2 percent from production in these same states in June 2006. May revised production, at 14.9 billion pounds, was up 1.1 percent from May 2006.

Production per cow during June averaged 1,713 pounds, 16 pounds above a year ago. The average number of milk cows in the 23 states was 8.29 million head, 19,000 head more than last year and 2,000 head more than May 2007.
