AUSTIN . . . According to the Texas Field Office, wheat stored in all positions on September 1 totaled 64.3 million bushels, compared with 87.1 million bushels a year ago. This inventory is down 26 percent from last year. Farm stocks totaled 5.8 million bushels, up 3 million bushels from a year ago. Off-farm stocks totaled 58.5 million bushels, down 31 percent from last year.

Texas off-farm old crop corn stocks totaled 21.5 million bushels, compared with 15.2 million bushels stored this time last year.

Total old crop sorghum stocks in all positions in Texas, at 6.2 million bushels, were down 15 percent from the 7.3 million bushels a year earlier.

United States corn stocks in all positions totaled 1.62 billion bushels, up 25 percent from last year. On-farm stocks accounted for 500 million bushels, up 9 percent from last year. Off-farm stocks, at 1.12 billion bushels are up 33 percent from last year. Wheat stocks in all positions totaled 1.86 billion bushels, up 8 percent from a year ago. Sorghum stocks in all positions totaled 52.8 million bushels, up 65 percent from September 1, 2007.
