AUSTIN . . . According to the Texas Field Office, June 1 stocks of sorghum in all positions totaled 15.4 million bushels, down 34 percent from the 23.4 million bushels on hand a year ago. On-farm stocks totaled 1 million bushels, up 67 percent from last year. Off-farm stocks, at 14.4 million bushels, were down 29 percent from June 1, 2008.

Stocks of wheat in all positions June 1, 2009, totaled 27.3 million bushels, up 4.5 percent from last year's level of 25.9 million bushels. On-farm stocks totaled 1 million bushels, up 44.5 bushels from a year ago. Off-farm stocks totaled 26.2 million bushels, up 3 percent from June 1, 2008.

The Texas Field Office no longer publishes on-farm corn stocks, but the off-farm storage, at 48.6 million bushels, was up 10 percent from a year earlier.

Stocks of corn in all positions in the United States totaled 4.27 billion bushels, up 6 percent from the June 1, 2008 level. All wheat stocks totaled 667 million bushels, up 118 percent from a year ago.

U.S. stocks of sorghum totaled 101 million bushels, down slightly from a year ago. Soybean stocks totaled 597 million bushels, down 12 percent; oats on hand totaled 17.5 million bushels, up 9 percent from June 2008.
