AUSTIN . . . According to the Texas Field Office, wheat stored in all positions on September 1 totaled 75.9 million bushels, compared with 64.3 million bushels a year ago. This inventory is up 18 percent from last year. Farm stocks totaled 3.8 million bushels, down 2 million bushels from a year ago. Off-farm stocks totaled 72.1 million bushels, up 23 percent from last year.

Texas off-farm old crop corn stocks totaled 23.7 million bushels, compared with 21.5 million bushels stored this time last year.

Total old crop **sorghum** stocks in all positions in Texas, at 14.0 million bushels, was up from the 6.2 million bushels a year earlier.

United States old crop corn stocks in all positions totaled 1.67 billion bushels, up 3 percent from last year. On-farm stocks accounted for 608 million bushels, up 22 percent from last year. Off-farm stocks, at 1.07 billion bushels are down 5 percent from last year. Wheat stocks in all positions totaled 2.22 billion bushels, up 19 percent from a year ago. Sorghum old crop stocks in all positions totaled 54.7 million bushels, up 4 percent from September 1, 2008.
