Oklahoma hatcheries set 5.67 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 20, down slightly from the week prior and down 23 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 20, was 3.66 million, down 27 percent from the previous week and down 23 percent from the previous year.

Texas hatcheries set 19.1 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 20, down 1 percent from the week prior but up 4 percent from the previous year.

The number of chicks placed for meat production during the week of April 20, was 14.9 million, down slightly from the previous week but up 3 percent from the previous year.
