\$32,873,000 in 2002, \$30,888,000 in 1997, up 6 percent.

### Market Value of Production, average per farm

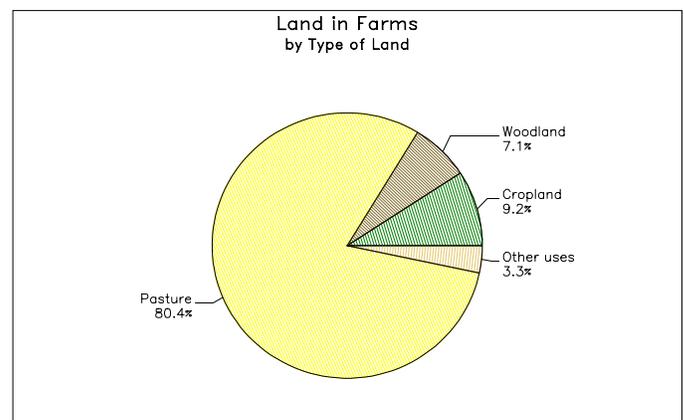
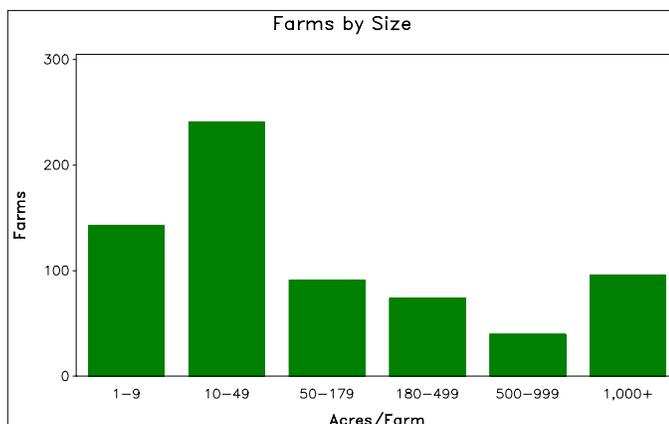
\$47,990 in 2002, \$51,826 in 1997, down 7 percent.
