Land in farms

Decreased 13 percent from 449,972 acres in 1992 to 393,162 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Decreased 21 percent from 1,751 acres in 1992 to 1,384 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Decreased 7 percent from 158 farms in 1992 to 147 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

Decreased 2 percent to \$19,256,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 71 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 29 percent of the market value.

Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Decreased 12 percent from \$76,817 in 1992 to \$67,802 in 1997.
