Land in farms

Increased slightly from 141,742 acres in 1992 to 142,940 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Increased 5 percent from 292 acres in 1992 to 306 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Unchanged from 270 farms in 1992 to 270 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

Increased 62 percent to \$109,461,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 1 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 99 percent of the market value.

Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased 69 percent from \$139,004 in 1992 to \$234,392 in 1997.
