Land in farms

Increased 3 percent from 117,168 acres in 1992 to 120,561 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Decreased 2 percent from 165 acres in 1992 to 162 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Increased 8 percent from 265 farms in 1992 to 287 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

Increased 6 percent to \$15,092,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 49 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 51 percent of the market value.

Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased slightly from \$20,146 in 1992 to \$20,340 in 1997.
