Land in farms

Increased 11 percent from 59,846 acres in 1992 to 66,569 acres in 1997.

Average size of farms

Unchanged from 128 acres in 1992 to 128 acres in 1997.

Full time farms

Increased 20 percent from 160 farms in 1992 to 192 farms in 1997.

Market value of agricultural products sold

Increased 12 percent to \$2,836,000 in 1997.

Crop sales accounted for 35 percent of the market value.

Livestock sales accounted for 65 percent of the market value.

Market value of agricultural products sold, average per farm

Increased slightly from \$5,413 in 1992 to \$5,454 in 1997.
