Corresponding data for other livestock producing States are from official reports of the USDA Statistical Reporting Service. Information on shipments, auction market prices, and special feeder sales are from cooperative work between the Florida Department of Agriculture's Market News Section and the Divisions of Inspection and Animal Industry, and the USDA's Livestock Division, Agricultural Research Service and Crop and Livestock Reporting Service.

Many livestock producers and ranchers, slaughterers, auctions, feed lots, and other agencies associated with the livestock industry offered suggestions or voluntarily supplied basic data used to develop these statistics. Their contributions are sincerely appreciated.

INTRODUCTION

This publication continues the series that began in 1963, and is designed to bring together, under one cover, livestock statistics from various sources.

For the most part, this issue presents price statistics, production and inventory numbers from 1965 to date. The production, disposition, and income estimates for some years have been revised on the basis of more complete data which have become available since the original estimates were made.

CATTLE AND CALVES ON FARMS

Florida's January 1, 1976 inventory of all cattle and calves, including both beef and dairy animals, totaled 2,920,000 head. This year's beginning inventory is 30,000 head less than a year earlier and represents a 1 percent decrease compared with an 18 percent gain the previous year. Cows and heifers that have calved on January 1, 1976 totaled 1,815,000 head, a decrease of 3 percent. Beef ranchers dropped 49,000 head of beef cows, and dairymen dropped 6,000 milk cows from dairy herds. Nationally, all cattle and calves numbered 128.0 million head on January 1, 1976.

Beef cattle and calves on Florida farms and ranches numbered 2,639,000 head at the beginning of the year. Cows and heifers that have calved numbered 1,419,000 head. Heifers over 500 pounds being kept for beef cow replacements numbered 258,000, compared with 265,000 on January 1, 1975. Beef cows on all U. S. farms decreased 4 percent; while heifers over 500 pounds for beef cow replacements were 19 percent below the previous year.

Florida's dairy cattle and calves totaled 281,000 head on January 1, a decrease of 1,000 head. Dairy cows, at 196,000 head, represent a decrease of 6,000 head. Inventories for other classes of dairy animals increased 5,000 head from their January 1, 1975 levels.

On January 1, 1976, Florida ranked 16th in the nation in total cattle and calves, 15th in milk cows and 9th in beef cow numbers. During 1975, 510,000 cattle and calves were shipped out of Florida.

CASH RECEIPTS

Cash receipts from Florida's cattle and calves marketed in 1975 totaled \$188,199,000, up 36 percent from 1974. Cattle prices in 1975 averaged \$25.10 per hundredweight, compared with \$31.00 in 1974. Calf prices averaged \$23.30 per hundredweight, compared to \$30.80 in 1974. Marketings of cattle and calves in 1975 totaled 763,930,000 pounds, up 70 percent from the previous year. Receipts from hog marketings totaled \$27,208,000 in 1975, an increase of 19 percent from 1974. Prices received for hogs averaged \$44.70 per hundredweight in 1975, \$10.60 higher than the previous year's price.

HOGS AND SHEEP ON FARMS

The December 1, 1975 hog inventory in Florida totaled 240,000 head, 18 percent below a year earlier. The 1975 pig crop totaled 295,000 head, down 24 percent from 1974. Pigs per litter in the spring of 1975 averaged 6.8 down 4 percent from a year earlier. Fall 1975 farrowings averaged 6.9 pigs per litter, down 4 percent from the previous year.

On December 1, 1975, in the United States there were 49,602,000 hogs and pigs, a decrease of 10 percent from December 1, 1974. All sheep and lambs on hand in the United States, January 1, 1976, totaled 13,346,000 head, 8 percent below a year earlier.
