## SUMMARY

For the year 1963, Florida farmers received around \$46,742,000 for poultry and eggs. Of the total, eggs accounted for 85 percent, broilers - 10 percent, farm chickens - 4 percent, and turkeys - 1 percent. Cash receipts for eggs produced have more than quadrupled from 9,660,000 in 1947 to 39,902,000 for 1963. In contrast, average layers have tripled during this period from 1,936,000 in 1947 to 6,303,000 in 1963. In the past decade, receipts and layers have more than doubled.

Eggs per layer in 1963 was at a level of 224, almost double the rate in 1924. These combined factors caused production to expand from 191 million eggs in 1924 to 1,412,000 million in 1963. Seasonal trend in egg production shows that the apogee of production is reached during the spring of each year, tapers off in the summer, and gradually inclines in the fall and winter seasons.

In sharp contrast to Florida in the past decade, average layers for the United States declined 5 percent. Cash receipts have declined 16 percent also. Eggs per layer has increased more slowly than Florida and stood at a level of 213 in 1963.

Price per dozen eggs for 1963 averaged 34.3 cents, higher than the post war years of World War I, but lower than those years after World War II. The annual average price per pound received by producers of chicken and commercial broilers is at a record low of 10.1 and 14.3 cents, in that order, whereas poult have inclined slightly in the past three years to 26.2 cents.

In the last 12 years, number of straight run chicks hatched have increased from 17 million to 36.5 million in 1963. Of the 36 million hatched, broiler-type eggs accounted for 18,290 and egg-type the remainder. Broiler-type chicks placed in Florida are at a level of 200 to 300 thousand each week.

Number of commercial broilers produced in 1963 totaled 9,721,000, a decline from the 11,830,000 record set in 1956. The leading Florida counties in broiler production are Putnam, Bradford, Clay, Walton, Alachua, and Madison, in that order.

Number of turkeys on farms January 1, 1964 totaled 25,000 valued at \$4.50 per head. Number of turkeys has been declining on farms since the high of 57,000 on January 1, 1959. Turkeys raised in 1963 totaled 226,000.

Straight run chicks hatched in the United States were 2,769 million in 1963. Of this number, broiler-type accounted for 2,254 million, and egg-type 515 million. The number of turkeys hatched in the Nation was 2,444,000. Broiler-type chicks are placed at a level of 30-40 million a week.

## Definitions of Poultry Terms

All Chickens - All Chickens, Excluding Commercial Broilers

Chickens Raised - Includes All Egg Type Chickens and Farm Broiler Type Chickens, but Does Not Include Commercial Broilers

Layers - Hens and Pullets of Laying Age (22 Weeks and Older)

Hens - Birds One Year Old and Over

Pullets - Those Included in January 1 Inventories as Pullets

- a. Pullets of Laying Age (22-52 Weeks)
- b. Pullets Not of Laying Age (13 to 21 Weeks)

Those Included in January 1 Inventories as "Other Chickens"

Pullets Less Than 13 Weeks of Age (this practice is a holdover from the earlier years when chicks were all straight run and the pullets and cockerels could not be identified until the 12th or 13th week).

Broilers - Meat-type Chickens Raised Commercially to Weights Around 2.5 - 3.5 Pounds in 8-10 Weeks

Other Chickens - Pullets Less Than 13 Weeks of Age, Roosters, Farm Broiler Chickens (Non-Commercial)


## FLORIDA POULTRY PRODUCTION

Commercial Egg Production is Florida's major poultry enterprise. Growth and expansion of the industry has more than kept pace with a population increase of 79 per cent during the 1950-60 decade and Florida producers now supply approximately 85 per cent of the State's egg requirements. During certain periods of the year, substantial volumes are shipped to northern metropolitan markets.

Broiler production, which is concentrated in five northeast and northwest counties, has fluctuated between 10 and 12 million birds annually during the last decade. Most of this production is consumed within the State and represents approximately 25 per cent of total demand.


Several commercial turkey farms are situated in Central and Northeast Florida.

EGGS: Daily Average Number of Eggs Produced per 100 Layers, by Months, Florida, 1950-63



FLORIDA POPULATION, JULY 1, 1950-63

Since 1950 the rate of population has more than doubled in Florida. The rate of tourists visiting our state has tripled. Each tourist stayed in Florida an average length of 11 days during 1963. Food and drink consumed in restaurants and bought at stores amounted to 27 per cent of the tourist dollar. Hence, as can be seen, these are contributing factors to our rising poultry industry.


Population in Florida, 1950-63






