

Full Names for Shortened Names in Top Crops List

Shortened Crop Name	Full Name (as listed in <i>2022 Census of Agriculture</i> , vol. 1)
Artichokes	Artichokes (excluding Jerusalem)
Bedding/annuals/perennials	Bedding/Garden plants – annuals, herbaceous perennials, vegetable plants (include hanging baskets)
Blackberries and dewberries	Blackberries and dewberries (including marionberries)
Bulbs/corms/rhizomes/tubers	Bulbs, corms, rhizomes, and tubers – dry
Cabbage, Chinese	Cabbage, Chinese (nappa, bok choy, etc.)
Cut flowers/greens	Cut flowers and cut florist greens
Cuttings/seedlings/liners	Cuttings, seedlings, liners, and plugs
Dry edible beans	Dry edible beans, excluding chickpeas and limas
Foliage plants, indoor	Foliage plants, indoor (include hanging baskets)
Forage (hay/haylage), all	Forage – land used for all hay and haylage, grass silage, and greenchop
Other floriculture	Other floriculture and bedding crops
Peas, Chinese	Peas, Chinese (sugar, snow)
Peas, southern (cowpeas)	Peas, southern (cowpeas) – blackeyed, crowder, etc.
Peppers, Bell	Peppers, Bell (excluding pimientos)
Peppers, other than Bell	Peppers, other than Bell (including chile)
Plumcots and pluots	Plumcots, pluots, and other plum-apricot hybrids
Sorghum for silage/greenchop	Sorghum for silage or greenchop
Tobacco transplants	Tobacco transplants to farm fields
