# Hawaii Agricultural Exports

The Hawaii Field Office of USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service estimates the value of agricultural commodities exported to the continental United States at \$420 million during the 2006 calendar year which is down 4 percent from the 2005 estimated value.

The United States Department of Agriculture's Economic Research Service estimates the value of Hawaii agricultural exports to foreign countries at \$96 million during the 2006 federal fiscal year (October 1, 2005 to September 30, 2006), up 1 percent from the previous year. Foreign agricultural exports from Hawaii for the 2005 federal fiscal year was estimated at \$95.1 million.
