2000 IDAHO WHEAT VARIETIES



Westbred 936 surpassed Penawawa to become Idaho's most popular wheat variety. Penawawa had been the top variety for the past six years. Statewide, 12.9 percent of all wheat acreage is seeded to Westbred 936. Other top five varieties are: Madsen, second with 12.6 percent; Penawawa, third with 11.5 percent; Stephens, fourth with 10.9 percent; and Weston, fifth with 4.6 percent.

Varieties decreasing in rank are: Penawawa, from 1st to 3rd; Stephens, from 3rd to 4th; Malcolm, from 5th to 6th; Promar Select (ID377S), from 8th to 9th; Daws, from 7th to 12th; Wawawai, from 14th to 18th; and Promontory, from 18th to 19th. Other varieties that dropped out of the top twenty are Pinnacle, Bonneville, Rick, Rod, and Pondera. Varieties increasing in rank are: Westbred 936, from 4th to 1st; Weston, from 6th to 5th; Westbred 926, from 9th to 7th; Garland, from 13th to 8th; Cashup, from 16th to 10th; and Treasure, from 17th to 15th. Varieties

not ranked last year include: Klasic, 13th; Utah 100, 14th; Hyak, 16th; Manning, 17th; and Westbred 906R, 20th. Brundage, a soft white winter variety, is not among the state's top twenty, but is the fifth most popular variety in District 70. Growers planted 2,600 acres of Brundage in District 70 and 10,300 acres statewide.

By class, soft white winter wheat accounted for 39.9 percent with 546,000 acres planted. Soft white spring wheat accounted for 16.6 percent with 228,000 acres planted. Hard red spring wheat accounted for 22.1 percent with 303,000 acres seeded. Hard red winter wheat accounted for 13.8 percent with 189,000 acres seeded. Hard white spring wheat increased to 4.3 percent with 59,000 acres planted. Hard white winter wheat accounted for 0.7 percent with 10,000 acres planted. Club wheat totaled 35,000 acres, 2.6 percent of Idaho's planted acreage.
